A friend (Steve Stone) showed me the site MagCloud, and off my imagination went, and landed here. And now I put my hand out to you for help and collaboration.

Currently I am looking for:

My friends to get involved! Hence why I am sending this to you! For sure volumes I wouldn't mind spreading it out to friends-of-friends, but part of my inspiration for this was to give the creative people I know a chance to get published and to be a part of the process.

These are a few of the types of people I am looking for:

Artists to showcase their work, 1-3 pages or more, it can include a bio, images, written word, etc.....

Writers - do you love to write about art, do you love to critique art? Let me know I would love to hear what you have to say

Critics - (in relation to above) do you love to talk about art, specifically critique it, If you have some credentials then you could be a fantastic contribution to this project!!

Do you think you can contribute in another way? Let me know!!! For example I will need someone to help me edit and proof content (2 sets of eyes are better than one!)

What's in it for you?

Well, simply put, a chance to get your voice/art out there. Everyone is on the internet these days, and we will be too - but nothing can replace the experience of holding something in front of you and being able to show someone a page in a magazine. We also don't know how well the internet will archive 50 yrs from now, but we know a magazine will still be around. I want to be published, so I am making it happen, and I want to be able to share it with my immediate inspirers and coconspirators.

To start off, the magazine will be published through a website called MagCloud. <http://magcloud.com> The price will be based on how many pages we make it, Magcloud only charges \$.20 a page - and we are then allowed to charge extra on the site for profit. (if we have any profit I would love to put it towards the website, promotion and buying extra copies to hand out.) So if we have a magazine with enough content for 20 pages, then the cost of each issue is only \$4. MagCloud allows you to buy in bulk and the shipping costs are really good!, Oh - and the best part - NO minimum! You can just buy one - and keep it for yourself! Anyone can buy the magazine and you can also promote it through your sites as well.

What do I do with the magazine?

When I think of how to use this magazine, first I will make sure all of my family buys one! (you know they will!!!) Second, I may pick up a few extra copies to leave at various places where it may get read..... for example my office..... school.....dance studio...gallery.....etc... and if everyone who contributes does that, then all of our work will be seen by many.

For anyone who contributes, you have the full reign of promoting yourself, and I want to involve as much of the arts as there is a desire for it. So consider this a way for you to put yourself in someone's hands and they can pass you along as they see fit.
